You then would forward these calls to available volunteers on the 12th Step List or simply answer questions about meeting times and locations.

The 12th Step List is also in need of volunteers to answer 12 Step calls which come into the office; six months of sobriety is required. Please consider being involved in this very crucial form of AA service. For more information or to volunteer please call the Intergroup Office or ask your Intergroup Rep. for the sign-up list.

The Intergroup Service Committee seeks to fulfill any special need or request of the groups, such as sign language interpreter. If your group is in need of a special service, please contact the Intergroup office.
