1. General Service/Intergroup Liaison: Joan H Liaison Report for May 2, 2007-I attended the South Florida Quarterly-Assembly on April 15th at the Crown Plaza in Tampa. (4/13/, 4/14/ 4/15/) On Saturday throughout the day all committees went over the conference agenda items which belonged to their committee for a group conscience. On Saturday night at 10:00 P.M. each chair of each committee was asked to give an oral report. I believe I last for a couple of hours. The one that interested me was the Pl./CPC chaired by Kevin S. explaining how it was until this year that each time a new video was made that they were discarding an old one! This year they will vote to continue this practice... Do we want to continue the 3 year cycle of the AA survey questionnaire? The motions passed on the agenda were motions A and C as B was withdrawn as they finally found it for current practices and moved it to the correction placement. There were 539 in attendance at the Sunday business meeting. On April 22, 2007, District 8 met on the 3rd Sunday due to the Quarterly-Assembly plus Easter. Next month it again will be the 3rd Sunday due to other's Day (May 20th.) The usual Agenda was followed today but first we met in our joined sharing session led by Clancy C. the DCM Coordinator. The topic was how do we get our groups to be interested in our reports as GSR's? Different people shared their experiences. There was motion from the recording secretary to make the DCM Coordinator responsible for the information listed in our minutes for all DCMs and ADCM's but was tabled until August due to the new District Ad-Hoc Committee needs 3 months at least to start on our Legacy of Service for the district headed by Gary B. a past chair.
