There also a great need for women to cover the main jail at Gun Club on Wednesday night or the law library alternate weeks at 2:00 p.m. We would be happy to give a new volunteer a buddy (service sponsor) as each new member is required to speak at 2 meetings with another committee member. Today at Orientation there were five(5) new volunteers which from last month's total, there were only 1 present to be voted in this month. The new officers coming in on April 15th, for a year are: Chair: Lynda W., Vice Chair: Tom K., Treasurer: Robert N., Secretary again is Katie C..
